

MOST SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INFORMATION:

1. Applicant may request a Scholarship once per calendar year.
2. There are limited needs-based scholarships available. If you have limited resources, we would encourage you to apply by completing this Scholarship Application. Scholarship decisions will be based on the information provided on the application, funds available, and the amount of personal support raised.
3. Applicants must complete for themselves the Scholarship Request form.
4. Within two weeks following the Mission Trip, applicant must submit to MOST a written testimony of the trip, how the trip impacted the lives of the people encountered and how the trip impacted his or her life.

POLICY

1. This scholarship will be awarded as part of the final payment toward the trip.
2. This scholarship cannot be received as cash or given directly to an individual. Payment must be paid to the sponsoring organization on applicant's behalf.
3. If payment is made and the trip is cancelled or applicant is not able to participate, the funds allocated by MOST will be returned to the MOST funding account.
4. The applicant must have attended CUMC for 12 months or longer prior to be eligible to request a scholarship.
5. All applicants are expected to participate in all fundraising opportunities.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. Complete the Mission Trip Scholarship Application, providing information that you believe will be useful to MOST in consideration for the Scholarship.
2. MOST will review applications during their quarterly scheduled meetings (See application due dates on the church website). Please consider this when determining when to submit your application.
3. Provide information, as you feel comfortable. Our goal is not to intrude on anyone's personal lives, but rather to disburse the limited funding that is available in the most equitable manner. The more information you provide, the easier our funding decision will be.
