Similar missions at CUMC such as Watchmen of the Street and the Furniture Ministry will continue to serve these clients.

Youth Mission Trips: Our Clemmons: One youth are living out the commission to go out into the world and share the love of Christ this Summer. We have a team of 17 who will be in ministry with children's homes in San Pedro Sula, Honduras from June 27 to July 4. We also have a team of ten who will be learning from and loving on our brothers and sisters experiencing homelessness in Asheville from July 10 to July 16. Our mission team of 30 will be out July 17 through July 23 to build and work on safe access projects such as wheelchair ramps and stairs in Watauga and Avery counties for those in need. Our summer of missions will then come to a close with our Middle School Mission Camp serving Clemmons and Winston-Salem from August 1 to 3. Please be in prayer over our youth mission teams and the adult leaders who have graciously taken time out of their summer to be in ministry with our youth.

Middle School Mission Camp: Calling all rising 6th-rising 9th graders for our Middle School Mission Camp from August 1 through 3 (9:30 a.m.-5:30 p.m. each day). We will be serving our community (Clemmons/Winston-Salem) with projects that range from building wheelchair ramps / porches / stairs, to serving at a food pantry or visiting and sharing a smile with those in nursing homes or hospice care.
